

# CLUB 800 2022

## GODMANCHESTER COMMUNITY ASSOCIATION

A growing group of residents have joined this community charitable activity, which revolves around a monthly draw - 47% of the receipts as prize money - 47% of which is distributed to worthy local causes of your choice - and 6% covering administration costs.

Participation takes the form of a minimum annual commitment of £12, giving you 12 monthly entries (shares/lucky numbers). If you wish to commit to a larger stake in the draw, that's not a problem. The draw (figures based on last year) - **1st £300, 2nd £120, 3rd £100, 4th £80, 5th £30 + a Christmas Bonus** - is carried out by the Town Mayor at the monthly Town Council meeting.

**Payment:** either by **cheque** - made payable to **Godmanchester Community Association** - for the full amount dated **1 March**; by **cash**; or, for **4 or more shares** by **monthly standing order** - first payment due on **1 April 2022 x 11**. For the first month's shares a **deposit payment** - post-dated 1 March - will be required with the application form.

**Good causes: please indicate below** which of the causes you wish your contribution to support. If you have four or more shares you may nominate two causes. If you do not wish to do this, the contribution will be set against the **Rolling Fund**.

- CAUSE 1 ROLLING FUND\*** - £4,000 has been set aside for safety works to the Recreation Ground swimming steps project - following agreement on the submitted plan.
- CAUSE 2 ST MARY'S TRANSFORMATION FUND\*** - planning is afoot to convert the nave in St Mary's Church to a more community-friendly area including meeting rooms, toilets and other amenities. To date members have contributed £5,000 towards this cause together with £3,300 for the roof restoration.
- CAUSE 4 PICNIC IN THE PARK\*** - having listened to essential feedback, we have returned this event back to a fun, family get together. With the return of the 2021 event in September it proved that this was a popular decision - for the GCA's team also. A children's entertainer on site during the afternoon meant family members could enjoy the music and chill. Although we have introduced an entry charge - together with financial support from the Town Council - it is still proving difficult to break even. Therefore, the contribution from CLUB 800 members is invaluable. In 2022 we return to our usual summer month for this event - Sunday, 3 July.
- CAUSE 5 SMALL GROUPS' FUND\*** - to offer funding which will assist with activities and, subsequently, make a difference to non-commercial Groups in Godmanchester - details have been posted to social media sites and the GCA's website.
- CAUSE 6 NEW YEAR'S EVE\*** - following lockdown, the 2020 funds ensured 2021 was a 'free' event - celebrations enjoyed by many. However, we need to ensure this event is 'bigger and better' in 2022.
- CAUSE 7 THE POLLARDING SOCIETY GREEN FUND\*** - the ambitious projects undertaken by this part of the Community Association has been admired by several groups and organisations from outside of the Town. In 2022, 2 of the 10 pollarded willow trees will be topped and the prunings used in the Willow Nursery for growing on. Donations also enabled the relevant equipment to be purchased - including pumps, chain saws, bush cutters and hedge trimmers.
